OFFICIAL RULES

1. Iowa fishing laws will govern all fishing. In addition, all fish entered in the contest must be caught by hook in the mouth.
 2. All contestants must have registration complete.
 3. The fish must be caught by hook and line and have a witness to verify the same to win the grand prize.
 4. All fishing equipment subject to inspection by officials to make contestant eligible for prizes.
 5. All fish must be caught during the tournament hours of 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM.
 6. Boundaries:
All fish entered in competition must be caught in the Turkey River and/or its tributaries.
 7. Competition will begin at 7:00 AM and close at 3:00 PM.
 8. Any fish caught, that is to be entered in competition must be brought in alive to be judged and weighed or is disqualified immediately, if necessary. Official judges have the right to disqualify any contestant if there is any question regarding legality of fish or contestant.
All fish must be turned in by 3:00 PM.
 9. All fish entered become property and responsibility of the contestant.
 10. The decision of Redhorse Fisheree Commttee will be final in all matters.
 11. The Committee reserves the right to disqualify any contestant if there is any reasonable proof or if in their opinion, only part of the group is registered.
 12. Because of weather conditions it will be the decision of the committee to:
(hold fisheree, postpone or cancel fisheree)
Any violation of the above rules will be just cause for disqualification of contestant, who could be barred from all competition.
To give the true sportsman an even break, we can and will disqualify any contestant or group, if the committee has any proof in their opinion, that said contestant or group is cheating in any way.
