The Elkader Area Chamber of Commerce offering *double punches* on their holiday punch card promotion.

The historic Keystone Bridge in downtown Elkader reopens for all traffic on December 1, 2023 having been closed since April 2022. The Keystone Bridge, built in 1889 of locally quarried limestone, is the only access across the Turkey River in town for both cars and pedestrians.

The initial construction cost for the rehabilitation was projected to be \$3,970,045, paid by a combination of state and federal monies with the City paying \$655,000 for engineering plus incidentals. The current total projected cost of the project, after repairing the crack, is \$7,348,517. The City is still looking for \$1,957,228 so they will not have to bond more for this project.
